
8 June 2018 [39.09 CHINA COMMAND STRUCTURE DIAGRAM]



NOTES: British Troops in China was an independent command reporting to the Colonial Office until the outbreak of war, from when it reported to the War Office. On the 18th November 1940, it became part of the newly formed Far East Command; the headquarters of which were located in Singapore. Teintsin was evacuated in December 1939.
