
## 8 June 2018 [39.09 CHINA COMMAND STRUCTURE DIAGRAM]



NOTES: British Troops in China was an independent command reporting to the Colonial Office until the outbreak of war, from when it reported to the War Office. On the 18<sup>th</sup> November 1940, it became part of the newly formed Far East Command; the headquarters of which were located in Singapore. Teintsin was evacuated in December 1939.
